VOCATIONAL TRAINING & PREREQUISITES

Vocational training is available at Adult Education Centers throughout Quebec in both English and French. The philosophy of these centers is *learning by doing*. Learning is acquired in realistic settings with state-of-the-art equipment. Upon completion of a training program, graduates receive a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) from the Ministry of Education. In today's labour market, technicians trained in Vocational Programs are highly sought after due to shortages in skilled labour.

All programs are tuition-free for Quebec residents who have the appropriate prerequisites as recognized by the Ministry of Education. Visit www.inforoutefpt.org for the most updated information.

Requirements for entrance into a Vocational Training Program:

Persons holding a Secondary School Diploma or its recognized equivalent degree.

OR

Persons who are at least 16 years of age on September 30 of the school year in which their training is to begin and have earned the minimum required credits in language of instruction (English), second language (French), and mathematics in a program of study established by the Minister, or have been granted recognition of equivalent learning.

<u>OR</u>

Persons who are at least 18 years of age upon entry into the program and have successfully completed the General Development Test (GDT), or recognition of equivalent learning.

OR

Persons who are at least 16 years of age on September 30 of the school year in which their vocational training is to begin in a specific program of study, who hold a ◀ **Training Certificate in a Semiskilled Trade (TCST)**, and who earned the required credits in language of instruction (English), second language (French), and mathematics in Secondary Cycle 1 in general education in the youth sector or in Secondary 2 in general education in the adult sector.
