INFORMATION ITEMS

School Hours

This year, the school day is from 8:57AM to 3:40PM. As always, students are expected to be on time to all their classes throughout the day.

First Days of School

Entry will be staggered as follows:

Students Attending on:	Grade Levels
August 30, 2023	Only Grade 9, 10, 11, WOTP (Day 1)
August 31, 2023	Only Grade 8 (Day 1)
September 1, 2023	Only Grade 7 and Learning Centre students (Day 1)
September 5, 2023	All students- grades 7-11 (Day 2)

Day 1 Information

- All students will use the main entrance on McLeod between 8:50 and 9:00 AM and will be guided to their homerooms.
- Our HSB Prefects (student leadership mentors) will be welcoming and guiding grade 7 and new Learning Centre students to their classes.
- All students are expected to wear their uniform.
- Students will receive their lockers, locks and combinations. Locks will be returned at the end of the year. Please remind your child not to share their combination or locker with anyone else. Also, valuables are to be kept at home as the school is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Students will receive a printed copy of their timetable.
- Students are asked to bring their own lunches and snacks on their first day back.

Lunch Options

The Cafeteria Services will resume as of September 5th, 2023 (Day 2). Students have the options of staying on campus in the cafeteria or outdoors or off-campus. All students are reminded to be good citizens whether on or off campus. Kind and polite behaviours are always greatly appreciated.

Uniform

Students must be in uniform as of the first day. The uniform is:

- White or navy blue tops with the embroidered HSB logo. Only solid white or navy tops can be worn under an HSB outer layer. For example, a plain white T-shirt under an HSB vest or sweater.
- Solid NAVY (no logos or patterns) bottoms consist of: pants (yoga, sweatpants, cotton pants, capris-no jeans) or Bermuda shorts (no short shorts).
- If students have not yet received their uniforms, they can wear a plain white t-shirt and navyblue pants or shorts until they do.

Moni will hold its uniform pickup day on Saturday, August 26th. Here is the schedule:

- 12:00-12:30 (Lunch break & catch up)

- According to orders placed by parents last name (not the students)
- Please note that ONLY the orders designated for school pickup and placed in June and July will be brought to the school. Do not come to pick up if your order was to be picked up at Moni outlet, if you requested home delivery or if you placed your order in August as your order will not be there.

Supply Lists

- The HIVE Middle School supply lists are accessible at <u>HIVE Supply Lists</u>. Supply details for other grade levels will be provided by teachers as they meet students over the first days of school.
- Students are expected to have their basics supplies as of the first day of school:
 - pencils, pens, erasers, liquid paper, ruler, highlighters, scissors, glue sticks, colour pencils, pencil sharpener, pencil case, face masks (optional), a **reusable** water bottle (we have lots of bottle filling stations), running shoes for Phys. Ed, facial tissues (optional). A quality backpack is a good idea.

Communications

- Our main way of communicating with you is through the <u>Parent Portal</u>. This is where you will find your child's daily timetable, report card, transportation information (if applicable) and more. This is also used to report attendance. In order to receive notifications of your child's absence from class, you need to download <u>Parent-Portail Parents</u> (by GRICS).
- There are times when we will send important information through emails. Please check your Spam folder as HSB emails may end up in that folder. We also communicate with our students using their NFSB accounts. Please remind your child to check their inbox regularly!
