First Day of High School!

The first day of school for Grade 7 students is Thursday, September 2. The school day starts at 9:05 a.m. and ends at 3:30 p.m. Students must be in their HSB uniform, ready to go! Whether your child walks or takes the bus, they will be met by staff as they arrive. Activities are planned to make our newest students feel welcome as they make their way around the school.

Uniforms

Moni Canada is our official uniform provider for 2021-2022. Moni is a Montreal-area company, and their uniforms are made in Canada. Uniform tops must have the HSB or Blazers logo and are only available through Moni. Uniform bottoms must be plain navy. Uniform bottoms can be purchased anywhere, but they are also available at Moni.

Although your child’s elementary school shared this information with you in early June, we wanted to mention it again here. Our HSB uniforms are made-to-order. Be sure to place your order by **June 30** to make sure your child’s order is in on time. See the attached documents for more information.

School Supplies

Teachers will let their students know the specific supplies needed for their class, but here’s a general “get started” list – pencils, pens, erasers, liquid paper, ruler, highlighters, scissors, glue sticks, coloured pencils, pencil sharpener, pencil case, face masks, a reusable water bottle, running shoes for Phys. Ed. A solid backpack is recommended! As the school is not responsible for any lost or stolen items, we recommend valuable items be left at home.
