Promotion to the next grade

At the end of a school year, decisions are made about placement and promotion from one grade level to the next based on specific, predetermined criteria.

In order to be promoted to the next grade:

In **Grade 7**, students must pass core subjects (*English, French, Mathematics*) and a minimum of 50% of the remaining subjects.

In **Grade 8**, students must pass core subjects (*English, French, Mathematics*) and a minimum of 50% of the remaining subjects.

In **Grade 9**, students must pass 2 out of 3 core subjects (*English, French, Mathematics*) and 2 out of 3 of *Science, History, and ERC*.

In **Grade 10**, students must pass 2 out 3 of *Mathematics, Science, and History*, at least one of *English* and *French*, and at least one of *ERC* and *Phys. Ed*, and have accrued at least 22 Secondary IV (Grade 10) MEES credits (appearing on the Ministry transcript).



Graduation Requirements:

Students must have a minimum of 54 credits including at least 20 credits at the Secondary 5 (Grade 11) level

AND

Students must pass the following courses:

- Grade 10 Mathematics (4 or 6 credits)
- Grade 10 History of Quebec and Canada (4 credits)
- Grade 10 Science & Technology (4 credits)
- Grade 10 Arts Education (2 credits)
- Grade 11 English (6 credits)
- Grade 11 French (4 or 6 credits)
- Grade 11 Ethics or Physical Education (2 credits)
