## Promotion to the next grade

At the end of a school year, decisions are made about placement and promotion from one grade level to the next based on specific, predetermined criteria.

In order to be promoted to the next grade:

In Grade 7, students must pass core subjects (English, French, Mathematics) and a minimum of $50 \%$ of the remaining subjects.

In Grade 8, students must pass core subjects (English, French, Mathematics) and a minimum of $50 \%$ of the remaining subjects.

In Grade 9, students must pass 2 out of 3 core subjects (English, French, Mathematics) and 2 out of 3 of Science, History, and ERC.

In Grade 10, students must pass 2 out 3 of Mathematics, Science, and History, at least one of English and French, and at least one of ERC and Phys. Ed, and have accrued at least 22 Secondary IV (Grade 10) MEES credits (appearing on the Ministry transcript).


## Graduation Requirements:

Students must have a minimum of 54 credits including at least 20 credits at the Secondary 5 (Grade 11) level

## AND

Students must pass the following courses:
$\square \quad$ Grade 10 Mathematics (4 or 6 credits)
$\square \quad$ Grade 10 History of Quebec and Canada (4 credits)
$\square$ Grade 10 Science \& Technology (4 credits)
$\square \quad$ Grade 10 Arts Education (2 credits)
$\square \quad$ Grade 11 English (6 credits)
$\square$ Grade 11 French (4 or 6 credits)
$\square \quad$ Grade 11 Ethics or Physical Education (2 credits)

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
